since you were here to see me, have had more sad news the death of Mrs Louise Y. Atkinson a sister of Clair and Clarence Younkin of Johnstown Pa. also the death of Mr. Shaffer who was married to Gertrude daughter of our old now dead friend

Daniel Younkin of Rockwood Pa. on going through some records I have found this in the old Church records of Bucks Co. Pa. the Baptismal record of 1790 Nockamiton Lutheran Church Child of Frederick and Barbara Denton Younkin, the child's name is not given, but proves

 first marriage, and it truly  
 looks now as if there was both  
 a Jacob and John, and it is  
 also possible that Fred. J. Younk's  
 father was this very Jacob. Just  
 had a letter from David of Johns-  
 town Dr. La. Younk of Othmanwa, Ia.  
 one from Mrs. Frank Jr of Ogden  
 Kan. Frank brother of Lou. L.  
 was married to Cora Swerner  
 whose mother was Barbara (Younk)  
 Swerner is it true that she was  
 a first cousin to her husband Frank  
 have been trying to run down some  
 new found ones of the Dan Younk's  
 of Buller Pa. have written him of  
 what I have found since Michael  
 Younk was in Bedford Co. in  
 1790 with a wife and daughter  
 in Bucks Co. Pa. a son of John

and Anna Maria Essig) Younkins  
 Michael was born in 1873, it  
 is true he would only be 17 years  
 of age, but just the same is  
 possible, as you know the  
 early Younkins were quite pro-  
 lific, so this is the only Michael  
 I have ever run across at this  
 early date. I may be wrong &  
 am awaiting word from Mr.  
 Dan Younkins of Butler Pa. to  
 find if he has any other news  
 of his, his branch as you are aware  
 the 1970 Pa. census does not give  
 any Younkins as they spell it  
 at this present date hoping to  
 hear from you in the near  
 future.
