like we have been known to do, and get lost
as long as you have been busy along the right
lines. You will be amazed in your tardiness
you speak of the John Younkkin having
two sons Scott and Frederick and a daughter
married to an Ansell, doesn't this sound as
though it could come from the Frederick
Younkin branch just follow up the names.
Possibly I am wrong, yes I have known of
this daughter she was a school mate of
my mother she will know her name and per-
haps will know of her husband. Mother told
me that Katie (Younkin) Frestone raised this
girl. This Katie was the wife of George Frestone
and an aunt of Daniel Younkkin of Rockwood
Pa, it begins to look to me like this whole
outfit I mean the Jacob grand father of

was a Doctor here in Perma ^{Levi} and at one time
had a tavern at Cornellsville Pa. and that this
Levi was a brother to Isaac younkini who was
the Grand father of this Dr Noble younkini here
again we have heard of this Doctor younkini i
believe at one time lived and practiced in
the neighborhood of New Lexington in Somerset
Co. do you know there is a history in Holland
of this younkini tribe that goes back 1000 years
how do you like that. come down any night i can
